# Site 1: Trailhead

- Will: Deer/Elk Habitat. Eating plants (Becca to supplement with Herbivory)
- Becca: Trillium- Mutualism with Ants
- Christopher: Holly Tree (Becca to supplement with Bird Mutualism)

#### Site 4: Fallen Log

- Will: Woody Debris as a habitat

## Site 5: Western Hemlock Plaque

- Jay: talk about tree
- Christopher: Succession
- Will: Black Bears (Becca to supplement with Omnivory)

#### Site 6: Vine Maple (should get here between 11:10-11:20; Midpoint)

#### Site 9: Witches Broom
